Week 1: Gauge Swatch and introduction to Mosaic crochet - US



Yarn

Durable Cosy fine, 58 % cotton & 42 % acrylic, 50g/105m/115yd

	Aurelia (yellow version)	Tortora (taupe version)	Rosa (pink version)	
Yarn A:	2133, Dark Mint	2211, Curry	229, Flamingo Pink	4 balls.
Yarn B:	2179, Honey	343, Warm Taupe	228, Raspberry	8 balls.
Yarn C:	2137, Mint	2239, Brick	203, Light Pink	3 balls.

Pattern Week 1

In the pattern, rows are crocheted using the mosaic crochet technique. To help you on your way, we start by crocheting a gauge swatch. You can find the photo tutorial after the written directions of this pattern. Make sure to count 2ch as 1st in rows 6, 8 and 10 (see pattern info).

Using yarn C and a 3.5mm/ US-E hook.

Row 1: RS: Start with 14fsc

- Total: 14st

Row 2: 1t-ch, 14sc. Don't cut the yarn, it will be picked up again in 2 rounds, together with the loop you had left on the hook.

- Total: 14st

Using yarn A.

Row 3: 1 standing sc, 13sc

- Total: 14st

Row 4: 1t-ch, 14sc. Don't cut the yarn, it will be picked up again in 2 rounds.

- Total: 14st

Using yarn C.

Row 5: Pick up the yarn from row 2 by pulling the yarn through the loop and next crochet 1t-ch, 1sc, [3sc, 2ch and skip 1st] x3, 1sc

- Total: 14st

Row 6: 1t-ch, 1sc, [2ch and skip 1st, 3sc] x3, 1sc.

Don't cut the yarn, it will be picked up again in 2 rounds.

- Total: 14st

Using yarn A.

Row 7: Pick up the yarn from row 4 and crochet 1t-ch, 1sc, [2ch and skip 1st, 1sc, 2ch and skip 1st, 1dc in the skipped sc of row 4 directly below your hook. The dc is worked in front of the st below] x3, 1sc

- Total: 14st

Row 8: 1t-ch, 2sc, [2ch and skip 1st, 1sc] x6

Don't cut the yarn, it will be picked up again in 2 rounds.

- Total: 14st

Using yarn C.

Row 9: Pick up the yarn from row 6 and crochet 1t-ch, [1sc, 1dc in the skipped sc of row 6 directly below your hook, 2ch and skip 1st, 1dc in the skipped sc of row 6 directly below your hook] x3, 2sc.

- Total: 14st

Row 10: 1t-ch, [3sc, 2ch and skip 1st] x3, 2sc.

Don't cut the yarn, it will be picked up again in 2 rounds.

- Total: 14st

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Using yarn A.

Row 11: Pick up the yarn from row 8 and crochet 1t-ch, 2sc, [1dc in the skipped sc of 8 directly below your hook, 3sc] x3

- Total: 14st

Row 12: 1t-ch, 14sc

Cut yarn. - Total: 14st

Using yarn C.

Row 13 – 21: Pick up the yarn from row 10 and crochet 1t-ch. 14sc.

Cut yarn and weave in ends.

If you make a lot of these patches, after finishing your shawl, you can crochet them together with a chain and you immediately have a nice garland.


