Durable Cosy fine, 58 % cotton & 42 % acrylic, 50g/105m/115yd

Yarn A:	2133, Dark Mint	2211, Curry	229, Flamingo Pink
Yarn B:	2179, Honey	343, Warm Taupe	228, Raspberry
Yarn C:	2137, Mint	2239, Brick	203, Light Pink

Pattern Week 5

Using yarn B and a 5mm/ UK-6 hook.

Row 93: RS: Attach yarn on RS using a standing dc in 1st st, 1ch, 1dc in next st, [1ch and miss 1st, 1dc] x83, 1ch and miss 2st, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in 1ch-space, 1ch and miss 2st, [1dc, 1ch and miss 1st] x83, 1dc, 1ch, 1dc in the last st.

- Total: 343st

Row 94: 1t-ch, 1dc in the 1st st, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x85, 1ch, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in 1ch-space, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x85, 1ch, 1dc in the last st.

- Total: 348st

Row 95: 1t-ch, 1dc in the 1st st, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x86, 1ch, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in 2ch-space, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x86, 1ch, 1dc in the last st.

- Total: 352st

Row 96: 1t-ch, 1dc in the 1st st, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x87, 1ch, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in 2ch-space, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x87, 1ch, 1dc in the last st.

- Total: 356st

Row 97: 1t-ch, 1dc in the 1st st, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x88, 1ch, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in 2ch-space, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x88, 1ch, 1dc in the last st.

- Total: 360st

Row 98: 1t-ch, 1dc in the 1st st, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x89, 1ch, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in 2ch-space, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x89, 1ch, 1dc in the last st.

- Total: 364st

Using a 3.5mm/UK-9 hook.

Row 99: 1t-ch, 2dc in 1st st, 180dc, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in 2ch-space, 180dc, 2dc in the last st. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

- Total: 367st

Using yarn A.

Row 100: RS: Attach yarn on RS using a standing dc in 1st st en crochet more 1dc in the 1st st, 182dc, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in 1ch-space, 182dc, 2dc in the last dc. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

- Total: 371st

Using yarn A and C.

Row 101: RS: Re-attach yarn on RS.

Start using yarn A. Crochet 1 standing trbl and 1trbl in 1st dc.

Now, also attach yarn C with a standing trbl. Please note! The last pull through of the double crochet stitch in yarn C is in yarn A.

*Place yarn C next to your work and crochet 1trbl using yarn A. Next, place yarn A next to your work and crochet the next trbl using yarn C; repeat from * 91x in total.

Place yarn C next to your work, crochet using yarn A 1trbl before the corner, in the corner crochet using yarn A,

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1tr, 1ch, 1tr in the 1ch-space and after the corner crochet 1trbl using yarn A.

*Place yarn A next to your work and crochet the next trbl using yarn C. Place yarn C next to your work and crochet 1trbl using yarn A; repeat from * 91x in total.

Place yarn A next to your work and crochet using yarn C 1trbl. Using yarn A, crochet 2trbl in last st. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

- Total: 375st

Using yarn A.

Row 102: RS: Attach yarn on RS using a standing dcbl in 1st st and crochet another 1dcbl in the 1st st, 186dcbl, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in 1ch-space, 186dcbl, 2dcbl in the last st. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

- Total: 379st

Using yarn B and a 5mm/ UK-6 hook.

Row 103: RS: Attach yarn in RS using a standing dc in 1st st, 1ch, 1dc in next st, [1ch and miss 1st, 1dc] x93, 1ch, miss 1st, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in 1ch-space, [1ch and miss 1st, 1dc] x94, 1ch, 1dc in the last st.

- Total: 383st

Row 104: 1t-ch, 1dc in the 1st st, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x95, 1ch, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in 1ch-space, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x95, 1ch, 1dc in the last st.

- Total: 388st

Row 105: 1t-ch, 1dc in the 1st st, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x96, 1ch, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in 2ch-space, [1ch, 1dc in next ch] x96, 1ch, 1dc in the last st. Cut yarn and weave in ends.

- Total: 392st

Finishing:


Make 3 tassels using yarn B.

Cut 15 strands per tassel with a length of approx. 20cm. Fold the 15 strands in half around a strand and tie a tight double knot using that thread. You will use this strand to attach the tassel to the shawl later.

At about 2cm from the strand, tie a second thread around your tassel and tie it tightly. Then cut the tassel to the desired length.

Secure the tassels on the three points to the shawl.
